When they leave the Healing Village, our expectation is they will be on their way to becoming strong leaders in our community. Ready to help lead other women on a similar path, creating a virtuous circle of female leaders. This is something I can get excited about. So many people in our community are living with trauma and we need to break that cycle. Breaking that cycle, however, begins with families and families begin with women. That's what our Healing Village is about, and I think it is long overdue.

I would like to thank the Sons and Daughters of Italy for their incredible generosity tonight in choosing the Clan Mother Healing Village for their charity of choice but also for all they have done in our community. This event is an amazing, unique event and requires a lot of hard work from a lot of people. Thank you for all for the long hours and dedication to help us to raise awareness for this initiative.

Also, thank you to all of the sponsors and attendees tonight. Your generosity is both inspiring and appreciated. I hope that you will leave tonight feeling filled with delicious Italian food and wine, while also feeling impacted and inspired.

Clan Mothers will create an Indigenous model of healing and education focused on the restoration of our communities based on the matrilineal values and principles of our original self-governance systems.



Clan Mothers is committed to the creation of a contemporary, sustainable Healing Village governed by a distinctive Indigenous council. The Healing Village will provide mid-term to long-term support to women who have been victims of multi-generational systemic trauma, sexual violence, sexual exploitation, and human trafficking to help them begin their healing journey.

The heart and spirit of the Village is the resurgence of Indigenous methodologies and world views to heal the most important beings in communities across Canada, the mothers and daughters of the next generation.

STRUCTURE AND PLAN

Clan Mothers acknowledges that there are a number of safe homes across Canada currently serving the needs of Indigenous women. The Healing Village concept is unique in this country because no other organization is addressing this need using a matrilineal focus, community living, and a commitment to use Indigenous holistic healing methodologies with social innovation. In fact, the project includes two separate and distinct units:

Clan Mothers Healing Village – providing healing and restorative programs for at-risk Indigenous women.

Clan Mother Earth Enterprises – identifying and developing a series of revenue-generating products and services to support the operation of the Village.

The vision is that Clan Mothers Healing Village will be located on a parcel of land in rural Manitoba, Canada. The site will be comprised of a mix of wooded lands, native grasses, and natural water sites that make it ideally suited to host outdoors activities and programming elements.

The Healing Village will be a sustainable site with the ability to operate off of the grid and generate its own utilities, including power, heat, and wastewater filtration. The site will incorporate solar powered energy, geothermal heating, and wastewater bio filtration systems.

An outdoor space is integral to the healing and educational aspects of Clan Mothers programming and the entire site is inherently important to the holistic healing process.

GERARDO LOMONACO COMPASSIONATE SOUL

Gerardo Lomonaco lives by the **principio**, “when you judge someone, you miss the opportunity to be kind to them.” This bottom-line belief in being a compassionate soul has been part of the affable restaurateur’s outlook since he was a child growing up in Winnipeg’s West End. That he still practices what he preaches on those same streets is a testament to his big heart. It also endears him to the city-wide community of customers and friends who affectionately know him as “Gerry.”

At The Original Sorrento’s Italian Restaurant on Ellice Avenue, Gerry goes about his days tending to the business that has been a mainstay of the downtown neighbourhood since 1975. The restaurant may be rooted in one of Winnipeg’s rougher quarters, but Gerry doesn’t see it that way. Wherever he goes, he says, there are no mean streets.

“We arrived in Canada from Italy when I was eight-years-old, and we lived on Victor Street,” Gerry explains. “It was a great place to grow up, and we all felt connected. The neighbourhood has changed over the years, but it’s still vibrant and full of people from around the world. It doesn’t matter whether you’re wealthy or from the streets, I’ll treat you as best I can to make you feel as comfortable as possible.”

Gerry’s efforts always start with a smile. If you’re fortunate to pass Gerry on a downtown street, he’ll say hello. If you walk in the front door of Sorrento’s as a customer, you’ll enjoy a meal in the warmth of the dining room. Even if you’re a hungry street kid looking for something to eat, Gerry and his staff won’t turn you away at the back door.

“Helping at-risk kids is nothing we want credit for; it’s just something that needs doing,” Gerry says. “Every day, they knock on the back door, and we’ll give them some breadsticks and a drink, and let them warm up.”

This humble approach to doing whatever he can to help the Spence neighbourhood and the broader community is at the heart of Gerry’s success as an entrepreneur and his accomplishments as a person. Whether it’s supplying food to the graduation dinner at Rossbrook House or the Sons and Daughters of Italy’s annual Christmas Eve Feast that feeds hundreds of Spence neighbourhood kids and their families, Gerry steps up with a smile to help.

For Gerry, doing little things for others is always a big thing. As a youth soccer coach, Gerry went out of his way to help promising athletes from the nearby streets become strong players and trustworthy citizens. He drove them to practices and games in other parts of the city and supplied them with proper clothing and footwear if it was needed.

Never putting yourself first is a virtue of a quiet champion. Gerry Lomonaco abides by the rule that the first question you ask when someone comes to you is, “how can I help?” For Gerry and his family — wife Debbie, sons Jeremy and Jordy, and daughters Carly and Kristen — being helpful is the first step to achieving great things.
